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Checkatrade.com imposters beware: We're on to you!

Selsey based company instrumental in jailing fraudster trading in Portsmouth.

Checkatrade.com has dealt another blow to opportunist rogue traders, after catching one not just engaged in bad practice but also falsely claiming Checkatrade.com membership and using its trusted logo on advertising.

Following a customer complaint, the firm investigated Keith Winning, trading as Portsmouth Plumbing & Heating, and found he was not and **never had** been a member.

Checkatrade.com provides only carefully vetted and monitored trustworthy tradesmen, so its team immediately alerted Portsmouth Trading Standards. Faced with a damning witness statement from Checkatrade.com and further staff willing to testify in court, Winning admitted to several counts of fraud, including falsely using Checkatrade.com's logo.

He received a 13 month jail sentence and a seven year ASBO will be imposed when he is released to protect the public.

Speaking following the judgment, Kevin Byrne CEO of Checkatrade.com commented: "This is a fantastic result in the battle against rogue traders. We want to send a clear message to con artists hoping to legitimise their activity by using our logo that we will not tolerate this behaviour and will take the most punitive approach possible. I hope that seeing a jail term handed down to a prolific rogue trader will act as a further deterrent to other such cowboys."

So far this year 55% of all customer feedback forms have been independently spot checked and verified to make sure the ratings are genuine.

Checkatrade helps combat the UK's rogue trader problem by continuously vetting and monitoring local tradespeople such as builders, plumbers and electricians as well as service providers.
